June 25, 2026 marks the sixteenth World Seafarers' Day. The International Maritime Organization has set the theme as "Carrying World Trade, Carrying the Risks." Mr. Terence Zhao delivers keynote speech, calling for attention to the value of seafarers

On June 25, Mr. Terence Zhao, Chairman of Singhai Marine, was invited to attend the sixteenth World Seafarers' Day thematic event organized by the Shenzhen Maritime Safety Administration and delivered a keynote speech titled "From Risk Bearers to Value Creators – Reflections on the Development of Seafarers in the New Era of Global Shipping."



Mr. Zhao noted that seafarers do not only serve the shipping industry, but also sustain the normal operation of the global economy. When the world focuses on supply chain security, we should pay even more attention to the people who support the supply chain – those people are the seafarers. Reflecting on Singhai's

twenty-one years of development, he remarked: "In the past, we worried about not being able to find ships; later, we worried about not being able to find seafarers; and today, we are even more worried about not being able to find high-quality seafarers who can adapt to future development." If the competition in the global shipping industry over the past few decades was about ships and capital, then over the next decade, one of the core resources in the competition will very likely be high-quality seafarers. Facing the two major industry transformations of green and low-carbon transition and digital and intelligent development, Mr. Zhao stressed that artificial intelligence will not replace seafarers, but seafarers who are adept at using artificial intelligence will replace those who are not. In the future, seafarers will not only be ship operators but should also become technology users, risk managers, and value creators. To this end, Singhai has established three training centres across the Yangtze River Delta and the Greater Bay Area, providing seafarers with next-generation simulators and cutting-edge hands-on training; meanwhile, through its investment in the AiSailings digital platform, it leverages data and artificial intelligence technologies to connect seafarers, shipowners, training institutions, and industry service resources, enhancing talent allocation efficiency, enabling more precise training, and making services more convenient.

He called on the entire industry to work together, emphasizing that we must not only train seafarers, but also think about how to retain them, develop them, and enable them to achieve success – enabling seafarers to grow from risk bearers into true value creators.

Singhai attends Zhoushan Seafarer Service Industry Promotion Conference



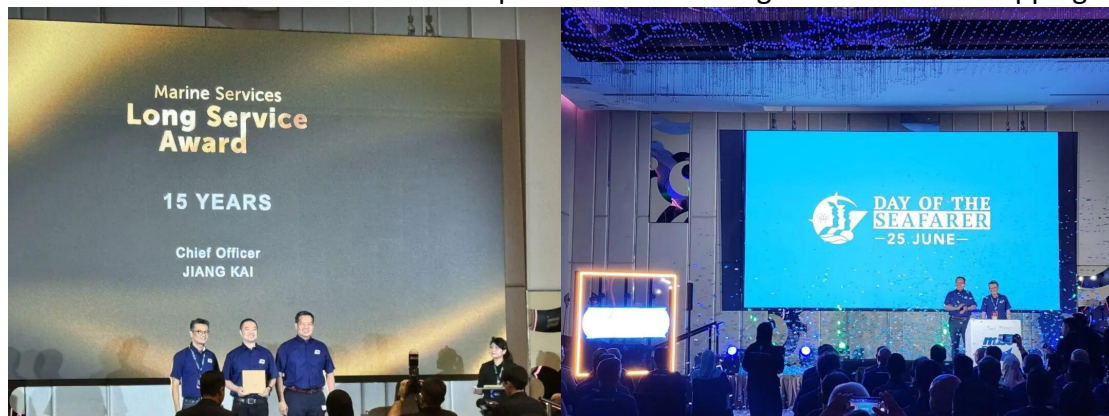
